(i) First Round Competition (6 April, Sat)

Launched in 2017, B.I.G. is a business idea competition which provides a platform for students to develop their business ideas, and showcase creativity. EIC welcomes students from all Schools and Faculties to join the competition, and help them connect with startup community. This semester, B.I.G. attracted 15 teams, with 41 local and non-local students teaming up for pitching.

As part of the efforts to cultivate students' entrepreneurial mind-set and innovative thinking, B.I.G. is a business idea competition, which participants develop their business ideas, and pitch in front of experienced judges. With the support of <u>LimeHK</u> (a HK based accelerator which helps early startups), the Final Round Competition of B.I.G.4.0 was held on 13 April (Sat) in <u>The Hive Kennedy Town</u> (one of the pioneers of co-working spaces) where provided a great opportunity for students to get real pitching experiences. In addition to cash awards, the winning teams were offered free co-working spaces and mentorship by <u>TusPark Hong Kong</u> (an entrepreneurial innovation and investment service platform) to further their businesses.

Step 1 Application

 - Evaluative Criteria: Innovativeness; Market Potential

Step 2 Preliminary Selection Interview/Pitching

- All participating teams will be invited to attend a preliminary selection interview and/or 2-minute pitching in the week of 25 29 March 2019.
- Teams will be notified of the results of the Preliminary Selection in early April by email.

Step 3 First Round Competition

- Shortlisted teams will present their ideas in the First Round Competition to be held in the afternoon of 6 April 2019 (Sat).
- Evaluative Criteria: Innovativeness; Problem Addressed; Market Potential; Implementation;
 Presentation

Step 4 Final Round Competition

- Five finalist teams will enter the Final Round Competition in the morning of 13 April 2019 (Sat).
- Evaluative Criteria: Innovativeness; Problem Addressed; Market Potential; Implementation; Presentation
